Educators/Faculty - \$95.00

A faculty member is any individual who teaches part-time, or full-time, in a program identified as "human services." Faculty in related fields (e.g., social work, sociology, counseling, psychology, etc.) are welcome to join as long as they support the mission and goals of NOHS.

Practitioner - \$95.00

A practitioner is an individual with a degree in human services, or a closely related field (e.g., social work, sociology, counseling, psychology, etc.), who works in any aspect of social services or mental health services in a direct service capacity with consumers (e.g., helping or counseling clients, supervising helpers, doing community organizing, peer helping, etc.).

Retirees - \$60.00

An individual can obtain a retired membership if he or she is fully retired as a human services practitioner, or human services educator, and has been an active member of NOHS within the past five years.

Associates - \$95.00

An individual who supports the goals and mission of NOHS but does not meet any of the other membership categories can join as an affiliate member. These individuals share all the benefits of membership except for voting privileges. Voting privileges can be obtained upon request by the member, to the membership committee, who will review said request and make a decision based on the individual's knowledge and commitment to the field of human services.

Students - \$35.00

A student is any individual who is currently enrolled in a course in human services or a closely related field (sociology, social work, counseling, psychology, etc.) and shares the goals and mission of NOHS. Students will be asked to submit the name of the current course(s) they are taking in human services and a contact number or email address of a faculty member with whom they are currently enrolled.
